POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position purpose

The purpose of the role is the delivery of an individual or group therapy program designed by an Occupational Therapist, either individually or under supervision of an Occupational Therapist or senior staff member.

Main tasks

Core objectives include:

- Delivery of therapy plans, and programs developed by occupational therapists.
- Therapeutic observations and note taking to relay to Occupational Therapist.
- Ability to communicate clearly both verbally and through written medium.
- Understanding of Rosewood Wild Therapy model, and a willingness to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Communicating professionally with clients and families on site, as well as with Rosewood Wild Therapy Director or contracted Occupational Therapists.
- Always practicing excellent OH&S.
- Willingness to work off site if required, for example, overnight camps or excursions.
- Willingness to assist in cleaning or maintenance of indoor/outdoor therapy space if required.
- Set up and pack down of indoor/outdoor therapy space.
- Preparing all activities and work area requirements for occupational therapy sessions.
- Ability to manage risk and safety through pre site checks and ongoing dynamic risk assessments throughout therapy sessions.
- Regularly read and review Rosewood Wild Therapy Risk Assessments and policies and maintain awareness of children with allergies/anaphylaxis/asthma.
- Basic computer literacy skills and ability to work across a variety of platforms including Microsoft Word, Google Workspace and Chat, and Power Diary.

Other Duties

• Fulfil other duties as required by management as required.

- Comfortable with outdoor play and risk taking.
- Physical fitness
- Ability to work under pressure and in all weather conditions.
- Organisational and time management skills.
- Excellent attention to detail.
